Niagara County Community College and Trocaire Dual Admission Program NCCC A.A. S. Nursing to Trocaire B.S.N Nursing (Completion Program) January 2024

Overview

Dual Admission is a special transfer program that utilizes an articulation agreement that typically guarantees admission to the upper division at four-year college upon completion of the associate degree. Advantages to a Dual Admissions agreement include early registration and guaranteed acceptance to the four-year college if terms and conditions of the agreement are met.

Niagara County Community College students who opt for the dual admissions program with Trocaire College will be able to enroll as a junior or a senior, depending upon how many courses are completed before transferring to Trocaire College.

A unique feature of this agreement is that NCCC students are eligible to jointly enroll in select courses at Trocaire before completion of their nursing degree. Students who take advantage of this enrollment option are eligible for scholarship funds that reduces the Trocaire tuition to the NCCC rate.

Benefits

NCCC students who have successfully completed the AAS RN program at NCCC and passed the NCLEX exam will have the potential to complete their BSN with Trocaire College in as little as 12 months after completing their RN program at NCCC.

NCCC students will also be able to take advantage of and complete early access course work at Trocaire (BIO 300, BIO 333, PSY 303, MAP) and transfer in all humanities, social science and statistics credits from previously completed coursework.

Highlights

- Students are granted guaranteed admission to Trocaire College and may have the opportunity to accelerate their pursuit of a BSN degree, possibly finishing in as little as 12 months if transfer credit opportunity is maximized.
- Students will be eligible for discounted BSN coursework at Trocaire and will pay NCCC tuition rates for select Trocaire courses while enrolled in NCCC's AAS RN program.
- Students will be offerd engagement opportunities to earn non-credit certificate(s) in Leadership or Cultural Competency to enhance their professional resume as well as participate in a service project that will fulfill Trocaire's graduation requirement ~ Mercy Action Project (MAP).
- Students will receive guided direction from professional staff members at Trocaire to keep on track with academic progress.

Requirements:

1. Student must graduate from NCCC;

2. Student must maintain an academic GPA required at Trocaire College;

3. Student must apply for Dual Admissions prior to the completion of 33 credits in NCCC's Nursing Program.

General Provisions

Term and Termination of Agreement. The term of the Agreement shall be effective Fall 2023 and be in effect until either party wishes to terminate the Agreement by written notification signed by the appropriate official of the party initiating the termination. Such notification must be received by the other party at least six months prior to the effective termination date.

Supersedes Prior Agreements. This Agreement shall supersede and replace all prior (Nursing Program) agreements and understandings, oral or written, between Trocaire College and Niagara County Community College.

Amendment of Agreement. This Agreement may be amended at any time by the written agreement of both parties. Any amendments to this Agreement shall be in writing and approved in the same manner as was used to approve this Agreement.

Indemnification

- A. To the extent permitted by law, Niagara County Community College shall indemnify, defend, and hold harmless Trocaire College, its agents and employees, from any claims, demands, or causes of action arising out of the negligent acts or omissions of Niagara County Community College, its agents or employees, in the performance of Niagara County Community College's obligations under this agreement.
- B. To the extent permitted by law, Trocaire College shall indemnify, defend, and hold harmless Niagara County Community College, its agents and employees, from any claims, demands, or causes of action arising out of the negligent acts or omissions of Trocaire College, its agents or employees, in the performance of Trocaire College obligations under this agreement.
