



HEALTH RECORD INFORMATION

Prior to registering for classes:

In order for student to register for the Spring 2019 Nursing Program classes, the following immunizations are required and must be turned into the college wellness center:

- Immunizations
 - Measles (2), Mumps, and Rubella
 - Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR)
 - Dose 1: At 12 month of age or older (provide month and year) and
 - Dose 2: At 4-6 years of age or older (provide month and year)
 - OR
 - Measles (Rubeola, Red Measles or Ten-Day Measles) - two doses of vaccine or
 - a positive antibody titer
 - Rubella (German Measles or Three-Day Measles) - two doses of vaccine or a positive antibody titer
 - Dose 1: At 12 month of age or older (provide month and year) and
 - Dose 2: At 4-6 years of age or older (provide month and year), or
 - Positive Antibody Titer (include copy of lab result)
 - Meningococcal Meningitis Vaccine (within 5 years) or decline sheet signed

The health packet and additional health records needed for clinical sites must be complete and received in the Wellness Center no later than **January 15, 2019**. Students will receive notification from the nursing program which documents are needed at your clinical site. ***Students will not be able to attend clinicals until all required health documentation is submitted.***

Prior to the first day of classes, students will need to submit the following:

- TDAP – Tetanus, Diphtheria, & Pertussis (within 10 years)
- **TST Skin Test (PPD) – a NEW test is required yearly** ○ *A recent copy from your place of employment is acceptable*
 - ***LPN Program only(unless otherwise notified by the clinical coordinator): Two PPDs are required 2-4 weeks apart (this is called a 2-Step PPD)***
(If TST is 15mm or greater, a copy of a chest X-ray report is required.)
- Hepatitis B Vaccine – 3 shot dosage, or a decline sheet signed
- Physical Examination or copy of a recent exam
 - Chicken Pox:
 - Date of childhood Chicken Pox _____
 - Date of Chicken Pox titer _____
 - Dates of Varicella Vaccine #1 _____ #2 _____
- HIPAA located on Trocaire Library home page

- Current CPR from American Heart Association (it must remain current during the program).
- **Influenza - Annually, *due 10/15/18 for fall semester, 1/15/19 for spring semester***
- **Flu shot – proof of this shot is required for clinical**
- **Or you must wear a mask and sign the declination flu shot sheet.**
 - **Some clinical facilities do not permit masks.**

For any medical or religious exemptions please contact the Wellness Center.

Please note that you will be informed of any additional documents needed for your clinical site by your clinical coordinator. Students will not be allowed to attend clinical if any of the requirements are missing.

If you do not have health insurance, please contact the Wellness Center for community providers.
